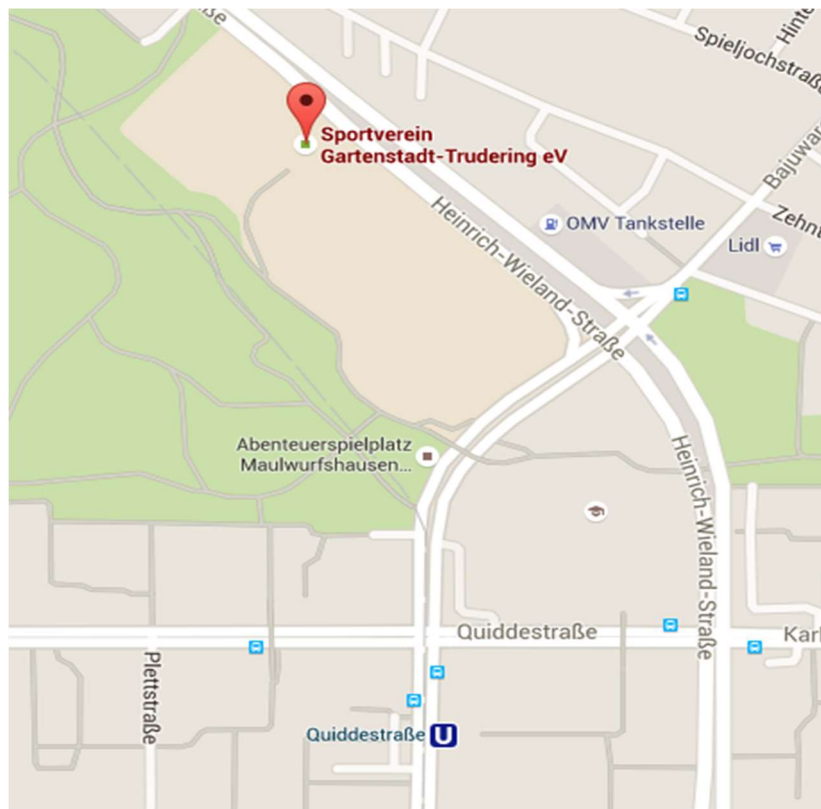

Facilities

We will be playing at our home grounds in **Heinrich-Wieland-Str. 102**, 81735 München – the closest U-Bahn / Subway stop is **U5 Quiddestraße**. From Hauptbahnhof / Central Station it only takes 25 minutes to get to the grounds (15 minutes subway plus a 10 minute walk). Free parking is possible at the street.

Please be aware that you might play on artificial pitches – absolutely no metal studs are allowed!



Lunch

A lunch-pack will be available for players on the day, containing fruits, sandwiches etc. and will be handed out to each team representative during the day. Water will also be available to each team from the info desk first thing in the morning.



Dinner and Award Ceremony Venue

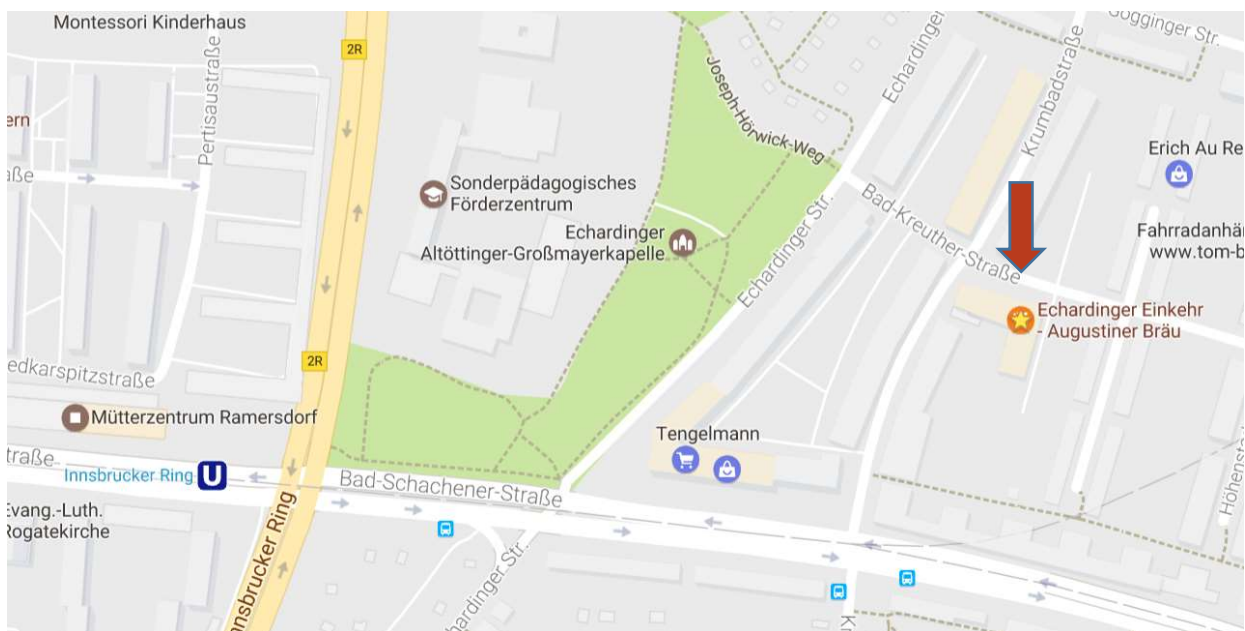

The dinner and award ceremony will take place in **Echardinger Einkehr, Bad-Kreuther-Straße 8**, 81671 München. It takes 6 minutes to walk there from the “Innsbrucker Ring” U5 subway stop. Free parking is possible at the street.

The dinner will be a 3 course sit down served meal at particular times so please be aware that you might miss a course if you come too late. Drinks should be paid straight away to avoid later confusion.

Please arrive to the venue by 8:00pm sharp!

Sightseeing (suggestions)

- Der Alte Peter: The church is directly behind Marienplatz and during the day you can walk up the tower to have an amazing view of Munich.
- Englischer Garten: For a kick around we recommend the English gardens. It's packed when the weather is nice but there you can find surfers as well as the beergarden at the Chinese tower.
- Free walking tour in Munich: 2 hours of Munich history with tipping in the end. Most of the tours start at Mary's column (Sandemans New Europe, Freetour, ...)



Travel/Logistics

Getting to Munich

- Munich is surrounded by a network of motorways from every direction.
- Major European cities are linked to Munich via bus and train (Flixbus, DB).
- Munich has its own international airport and is well connected to the rest of Europe by both no-frill and full-frill airlines. The airport is well-connected to the city via rail (40 minute journey to the Munich City Centre with S1 or S8). Memmingen Airport is 1:30h away by bus from Munich and is served by no-frill-airlines.

Public Transport within Munich

All transport in the greater Munich area is coordinated by the MVV organisation so the same day ticket allows travel on buses, trams, suburban trains and underground.

Single Journey Tickets are pricey so day tickets are recommended. Day tickets are available for 1 person (Einzel) or up to 5 people (Partner) tickets.

- There is a full network (Gesamtnetz) day ticket which covers you to and from the airport. This also covers a trip to Dachau.
- There is an inner zone (Innenraum) day ticket which covers the inner city, including Allianz Arena, Olympiastadium and travel to the pitches and the evening venue.

Accommodation

Munich is one of the leading tourist destinations in Europe. The city offers a wide range of options for every budgetary category.

HI Munich-City has deals from €25 a night, A&O München from €30, Meininger Munich City from €40 - all around Central Station/Hauptbahnhof.

15 minutes train + 10 minutes walk to the pitches // 12 minutes train + 6 minutes walk to dinner location.

As long as you are staying near an U-Bahn (i.e. subway station) any venue is easily reached!
